JURIED ART COMPETITION RULES

To be eligible to compete in the juried art competition, artist must present documentation of citizenship in a federally recognized Native American tribe. Tribal documentation papers and/or CDIB cards must be submitted with registration.

To be eligible for the adult categories, artist must be 18 or older by the September 7th. The youth categories are for ages 17 and under. Each registered artist is allowed three entries with their paid fee of \$10. No charge for youth entries.

The Native Fest Art Show

- Entries must have been completed during the last year. Entries must be dated, either on the work itself or on the Art Show identification label. Labels must be submitted with registration.
- Entries that contain parts of endangered species such as feathers, claws, bones, fur, etc. will automatically be disqualified.
- Entries containing sexual nudity will be disqualified.
- Entries must be painted on a generally recognized surface, such as, canvas, paper, Masonite, hardboard or plywood. Art on leaves, feathers or saw blades will be rejected.
- Entries must be original artwork by the registered artist. No collaborative work may be entered. Items must not have been sold prior to judging, must not have been commissioned, and must be the sole property of the registered artist.
- Entries must be in compliance with federal regulations as pertains to this show.
- Will not accept items that are cracked or broken.
- Will not accept Items that are not in compliance with the American Indian Arts and Crafts Act or any endangered species regulations (regardless of permanent ownership).
- All pottery must be fired to be eligible for entry and display. No unfired clay or greenware.
- Mail-in entries will only be allowed under special circumstances as approved by the Art Show Chair.

Submitting an item for consideration to the Juried Art Show judges does not create rights, guarantees or promises that the item will be selected as a winner in any category.

Each category must have four entries or that category will be combined with another category at the discretion of the judges. Judges reserve the right to withhold prizes in any category if the entries do not meet their standards. All decision made by judges shall be final.

Art Show Schedule

- Entries will be accepted – Thur, Sept 5 in evening by appointment and Fri, Sept 6, 8:30 am – 11:30 am
- Judging will be done – Fri, Sept 6, 1 – 4 pm
- Awards Reception – Sat, Sept 7, 2018, 11 am - noon
- Art Show open to Public - Sat, Sept 7, 2018, 12- 6 pm
- Artist can pick up entries - Sat, Sept 7, 2018, 6-7 pm

(Note: Powwow Sat Sept 7, 12-6 pm)

CATEGORIES AND AWARDS

Painting: Acrylic, oil, water color, gouache, mixed media.

Graphics/Photography: Graphics: Pencil, pen and pastel drawings, mixed media, lithograph, woodblock original prints including serigraph and etchings. No photo offset print including giclees or inkjet will be accepted. Photography: Black and white/color -plain or enhanced. All work must be original. Works must be matted or framed.

Sculpture: Bone, metal, stone, clay, paper casting, wood and glass.

Pottery: All handmade traditional and contemporary pottery forms are allowed. Allowable with disclosure: kiln- fired and or double fired Pottery, pottery made with commercial material, such as clay, glazes and temper. No greenware, no slip mold commercial pottery.

Jewelry: Must be handmade and genuine material. Traditional and contemporary jewelry is allowed. Sterling silver must be stamped or signed for authenticity. Method or production must be stated on ID card or attached to ID card. Please have a secure display. No non-Indian made heishi or fetishes. No plastic, imitation or reconstituted stones. No machine made silver, metal blanks or plated metal.

Basket Weaving: Hand-worked materials, including natural plant fibers, horsehair, yarn, horn and bone. Hand-worked and harvested materials and natural dyes are preferred. Commercial materials and dyes will be allowed, provided they are properly disclosed. List methods and materials on ID card.

Cultural Crafts: Cloth or organic material, clothing, weaving, textiles, beadwork, items not included in other categories such as doll, stickball sticks, baldricks, arrows, bows, knives, etc. Natural and vegetable dyes are encouraged. All other dyes must be clearly labeled. List your methods and materials on your ID card or attached to ID card for the judges information.

Awards

Duplicate ribbon will be awarded to all winners; one ribbon is for the artist and the other remains with the work to be given to a buyer.

Categories are eligible for 1st place, 2nd place, and 3rd place cash award for adult categories if four entries are submitted with discretion of the judges. Judges reserve the right to withhold prizes in any category if the entries do not meet their standards. All decision made by judges shall be final.

Best of Show Award: Prize will be announced at judging.

Youth awards may be in the form of prizes and not cash.
